The First grade and Second grade will also be using the Grow, Proclaim, Serve! This curriculum incorporates Bible stories, activities, crafts, videos, and games into a full faith experience for children. They will develop the skills to unlock the Bible message and grow their faith by leaps and bounds. Colorful, engaging, theologically sound materials invite children to explore the Bible in fun, age-appropriate ways, capturing their attention and ensuring that God's message is taken to heart. Children will discover that their faith can grow right along with them!

All Stars for Jesus

The third and fourth grade will be learning how to use their new bibles using, *Learning to Use My Bible* as their curriculum. This is a fun, hands on approach using maps, games, charts, and music.

At the end of the year they will know where the Old Testament and New Testament are and what they mean. They will learn how to look up scriptures and be able to look up their favorite bible stories in their own bible.

They will also learn about the sacraments of Baptism and Communion and celebrate the end of the year with their first communion experience during worship.

Bible Explorers

The fifth and sixth grade class will be using the curriculum *Tweens in Transition*. This class uses a contemporary weekly magazine with a connection to everyday living-using true, fictional, and mission stories, role plays and situations for discussions; plus activities for class interaction.

Spiritual Sidekicks

The 7, 8, and 9th grade class will be using the curriculum *Faith in Motion*, which will help this age group apply biblical truths to everyday life.

They will explore relevant life issues such as peer pressure, and important faith issues like, what does it mean to be a Christian?

The High School (10-12th) class will be using the curriculum *Attitude*. The goal of this resource is to strengthen the member's spiritual relationship with God and Jesus Christ. This curriculum will help them to apply the teachings of Christ to their own everyday lives in an environment where youth want to learn about God's word and feel invited to learn in a way that allows them to be honest with themselves, with each other, and with God.

Christian Education Service and Mission Opportunities:

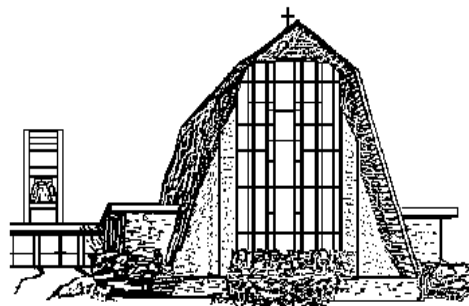
