

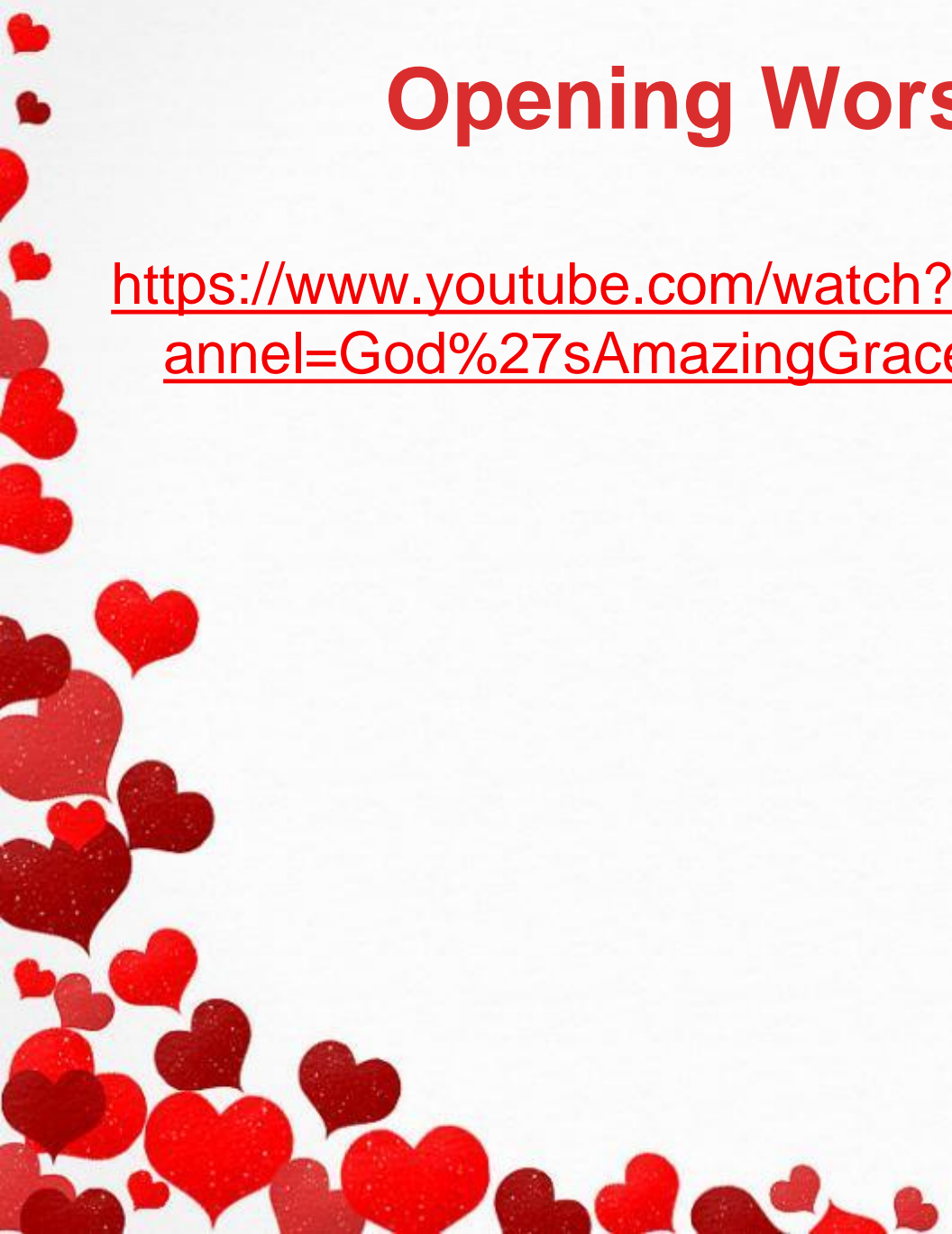

L: God's love pours into us.

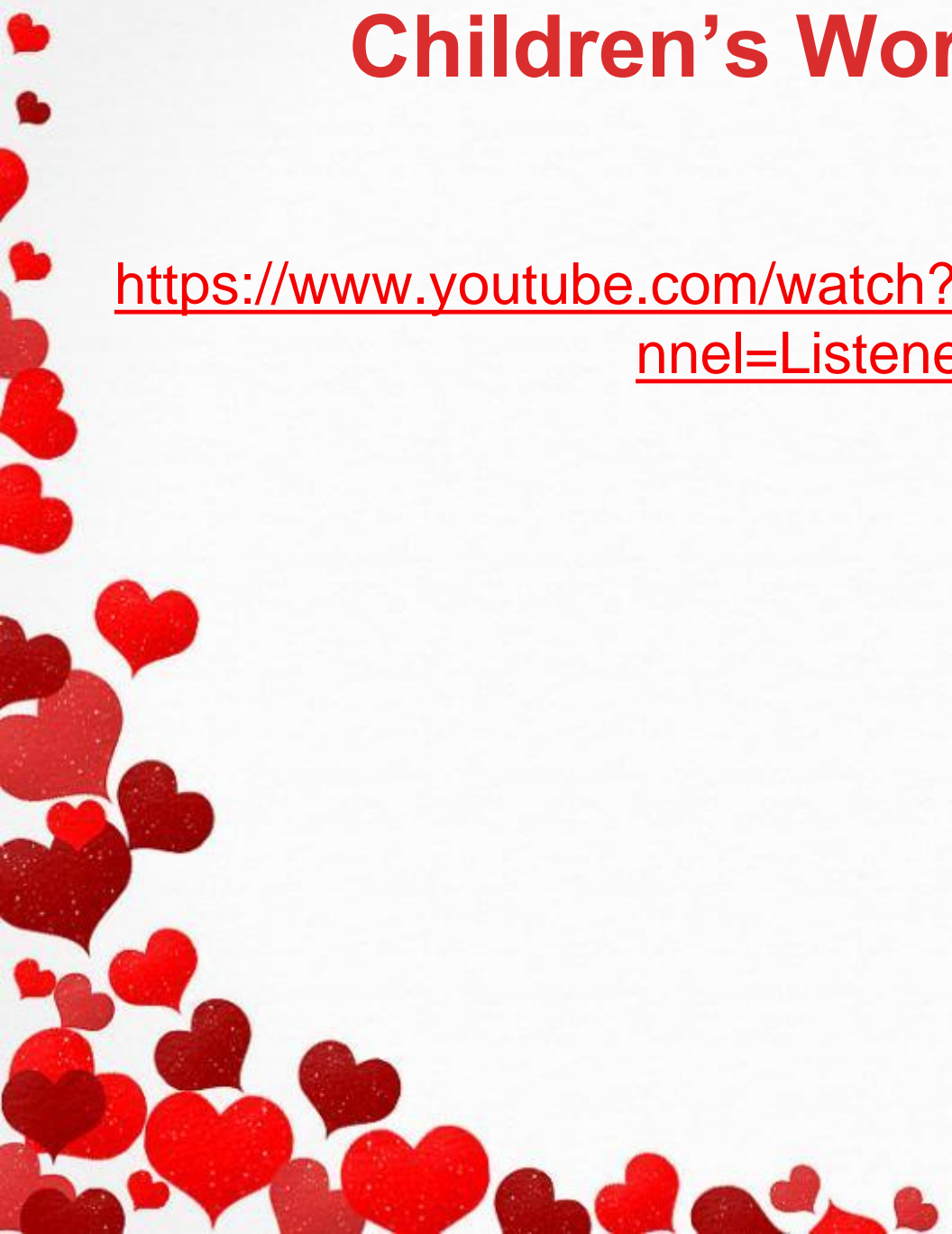
P: Lord, pour your love into every pore of my being.

Jeremiah 31:31-34

31:31 The days are surely coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah.

31:32 It will not be like the covenant that I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt--a covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, says the LORD.

31:33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

31:34 No longer shall they teach one another, or say to each other, "Know the LORD," for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, says the LORD; for I will forgive their iniquity, and remember their sin no more.



Youth and Adult Lesson

What do you think God means when God tells the Israelites (through Jeremiah) that God is going to “make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah?”

How do you think God felt when the Israelites broke his covenant?
Reread verse 32 for a reminder.

What does God mean when God says, “I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts”?

If we lived as if God’s law were “written on our hearts,” what difference would that make in our everyday lives?

How might non-Christians view us if they see us living in a way shows them that God’s law is written on our hearts?

Living in this way should reflect in our worship of God and how we relate to others. It should call us to take a self-inventory, recognize our sin, and repent of that sin.
